

Noosa District State High School Year 12 TrackEd: How to Interpret



The Results section summarises historical results for academic, behaviour and effort.

The Senior Schooling section lists the subjects studied and their results for Unit 1 and 2, and the first internal assessment (either listed under IA1 or IA2).

Results are colour coded to help interpret: Satisfactory and IA results above 50%: green; IA results between 40 – 49%: yellow; Unsatisfactory and IA results below 40%: red.

Est. Final column is predicting, if a student was to perform the same as the first IA task in the remaining 3 tasks, this is the cut-off percentage they would achieve. Each subject's A -E cut off is determined by QCAA at the end of the year, however at this stage should be sitting above 50%.

The VET section lists all qualification studied through Noosa District State High School. If the certificate has been attained, it will list the QCE points achieved. If the student is still working towards attaining, the points column will be blank.
