ARTS ACADEMY	Arts Academy students will develop their creative talents through opportunities within and beyond the core Arts curriculum. This program will develop abilities and skills beyond regular curriculum in an extended, engaging curriculum while assisting students to build upon critical and creative thinking skills. The Arts Academy will provide opportunities to further expand within Arts areas of: Media Arts; Visual Arts; Performing Arts - Music, Dance, and Drama. ATHLETE ACADEMY	The Athlete Academy is a program built on the Years 7–8 Australian Curriculum that supports the deepening of knowledge, understanding and skills in learning areas targeted at Health & Sport. This program tailors curriculum content to specific sporting areas where appropriate; such as Swimming, Cross Country, Athletics, Touch Football & Mountain Biking etc. Students involved in the Athlete Academy will be provided with first selection to participate within Interschool Sport Programs. It also aligns cross-curricular learning opportunities with high input from community organisations such as local businesses & sporting organisations. The curriculum continues to prepare students for civic, social and economic participation and personal health and well-being whilst providing increased opportunities for students to make choices and specialise in learning of particular areas of interest. This program incurs a \$20 fee for excursions. The class composition is reviewed every year in line with expectations set out in the student agreement.
