UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER (USI) - As of January 1, 2015 the Australian Government has mandated that students undertaking nationally recognised training delivered by a registered training organisation will need to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). The USI will allow students access to a USI account which will contain all of their nationally recognised training records and results from 1 January 2015 onwards. What this means is that any student enrolled in a Certificate I, II or III at Noosa District State High School, must register and create a USI which must be passed onto the school during the subject selection process. Noosa District State High School is then required by law to verify your USI before we can issue you with a statement of attainment or certificate. Step 1. Select

Students must:

- Complete all details on this page;
- Consider your pathway and make appropriate subject selections on page 2;
- Discuss your subject choices with your parents and teachers;

Step 2. Sign

- 1. Students sign and date the bottom of page 2;
- 2. Parents sign the bottom of page 2.

Step 3. Submit

Students must:

- Make sure you have completed all appropriate sections on this form;
- Bring this form with you to your SET Plan interview which will be held between the 9th and the 12th of September;
- Subject selection forms will not be accepted unless all sections are completed.

Step 4. Finance

Ensure the subject costing table (page 2) is completed during your SET Plan Meeting;

- 1. Include chosen subject names and costs
- 2. Total the subject costs
- 3. Add \$295* if participating in the 2025 Student Resource Scheme due 31/1/25 (*correct at time of printing; may be subject to change)
- 4. Total the subject fees and the student resources scheme
- 5. Complete the VET Statement;
- 6. After your SET Plan meeting your SET Plan interviewer will sign your form;
- 7. You will receive an email and a hardcopy of this form in Term 3;
- Once you have made a full payment on your 2025 subject and settled outstanding 2024 SRS, your subject selections will be finalised this must be done before October 17, 2024. Existing payment plans for 2024 will be at the discretion of the Principal and must also be organised by October 17, 2024.

***Where step 8 is not completed, students may be removed from subjects.

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Instructions

- 1. Select one subject for each of the six lines, ensuring that each subject chosen is on a different line from 1 to 6;
- 2. Select one English and one Mathematics option;
- 3. If you select Maths Specialist, you must also select Maths Methods;
- 4. Select four additional subjects, one from each of the remaining lines;
- 5. If you are wanting to attain an ATAR you must select at least 5 General subjects;
- 6. If you are not attaining an ATAR you should select at least one Certificate III or IV course;
- 7. If you have selected two or more Certificate courses, checked there is no duplication of learning.
