Step 3. Submit

Students must:

- Make sure you have completed all appropriate sections on this form;
- Bring this form with you to your SET Plan interview which will be held between the 17th and the 19th September 2025;
- Subject selection forms will not be accepted unless all sections are completed.

Step 4. Finance

Ensure the subject costing table (page 2) is completed during your SET Plan Meeting;

- 1. Include chosen subject names and costs
- 2. Total the subject costs
- 3. Add \$295* if participating in the 2026 Student Resource Scheme; due by 30/01/26 (*correct at time of printing; may be subject to change)
- 4. Total the subject fees and the student resources scheme
- 5. Complete the Fee Commitment Statement
- 6. After your SET Plan meeting your SET Plan interviewer will sign your form and it will be handed to the Finance Officer for processing
- 7. A \$50 deposit for the subject fees will be required at SET Plan (Week 10, Term 3, 2025)
- 8. Full payment of 2026 subject fees are due by 28th November, 2025. Partial payments and payment plans will be at the discretion of the Principal and must be organised with the finance team prior to 28th November, 2025.

Instructions

- 1. Select one subject for each of the six lines, ensuring that each subject chosen is on a different line from 1 to 6;
- 2. Select one English and one Mathematics option;
- 3. If you select Maths Specialist, you must also select Maths Methods;
- 4. Select four additional subjects, one from each of the remaining lines;
- 5. If you are wanting to attain an ATAR you must select at least 5 General subjects;
- 6. If you are not attaining an ATAR you should select at least one Certificate III or IV course;
- 7. If you have selected two or more Certificate courses, check there is no duplication of learning (see the Head of Senior School to do this).
