- 1. Noosa District SHS commits to every student exiting with a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE)
- 2. Every student must select **SIX** (6) subjects.
- 3. Select one English and one Mathematics option.
- 4. Use the 2026 online Subject Selection Guide: Senior Subject Selection Booklet 2026
- 5. If you are wanting to attain an ATAR you must select 5 General subjects.
- 6. If you are not attaining an ATAR you should select at least one Certificate III or IV course
- 7. If you select Maths Specialist you must also select Mathematical Methods
- 8. Some subjects have a recommended Standard of achievement in Year 10. Use the online 2026 Subject Information Guide to inform your selection.
- 9. Any fees incurred from studying course through external providers must be paid in full.
- 10. Some subjects attract an additional cost. There is a \$50 deposit required at SET plan meeting. The balance of subject fees must be paid by Friday 28th November 2025.
- 11. VETIS Funding Students who wish to access VETIS funding to complete a Certificate course should see the HOD Senior School (Ms Riley)
- 12. Some subjects may not be offered if there are low enrolment numbers and consequently students may be required to reselect.


