Instructions for Students

- 1. This subject selection is for the whole year and should directly reflect your Senior Subject Pathway (what you are likely to choose in Year 11 and 12).
- 2. All Year 10 students will study 7 subjects, including a Certificate II Course on Line 7.
- 3. Mathematics and English are compulsory; however, you need to elect which Mathematics course is appropriate for your pathway.
- 4. Students select ONE (1) subject from each line. You cannot select the same subject twice.
- 5. Use the 2026 online Year 10 Subject Selection Booklet
- You cannot choose Science (Core) with Science (Biology) or Science (Chemistry & Physics)
- 7. Students selecting Agricultural Science will also complete a Certificate II in Animal Care within the course.
- 8. Any fees incurred from studying course through external providers must be paid in full.
- 9. Some subjects attract an additional cost. There is a \$50 deposit required at SET plan meeting. The balance of subject fees must be paid by Friday 28th November 2025.
- 10. VETIS Funding Students who wish to access VETIS funding to complete a Certificate course should see the HOD Senior School (Ms Riley)
- 11. Some subjects may not be offered if there are low enrolment numbers and students may be required to reselect.


