Instructions for Students

1. All Year 9 students will study 7 subjects a Semester.
2. Mathematics, English, Science, History, Economics & Business and Health & Physical Education are considered core subjects and are compulsory.
3. Students select 2 electives for each Semester of study in Year 9.
4. Students select **ONE** (1) subject from each line. You cannot select the same subject twice, as no two of the same electives can be repeated in the year.
