Dear Parent/Carer

On Thursday 20th September the year 12 Economics students will be involved in a excursion to Fraser Island as part of their Term 4 studies in Environmental Economics. The trip is a full day trip costing \$95 which includes 4WD transport with Fraser Island Adventure Tours to the world heritage listed destination with BBQ lunch, morning and afternoon tea. During the day students will analyse first hand sustainable management strategies of activities on the Island in preparation for their last assessment item.

Activity details: The bus will depart from Noosa Marina would be 6.30am with a return of approximately 5.30pm. The tour will take in the coloured sands at Rainbow Beach, rainforest walk at Central station and a dip in Lake Birrabeen. Beach driving will be taken at low tide.

- Inherent risk level of the activities is Low with students being fully accompanied by a professional tour guide along with the teacher.
- Personal protective sun screen and water bottle is recommended. equipment or extra drink breaks / snacks
- Students may chose to swim weather permitting in the lake so please bring bathers, towel and a change of clothes.
- Students will take a walking tour a set track at central station and have morning tea and afternoon tea possibly on the beach.
- Travel can be bumpy on a dirt track so if travel sickness is an issue student can sit in front seat or we can stop regularly.
- Insect Repellant could be useful if allegic to sandfly bites

Activity Costs:

Students must be in financial good standing (Student Resource Scheme (SRS) fees up to date or entered a payment plan) to participate in the excursion. Those students who do not attend will be provided with alternate learning/assessment activities.
