Dear Parent/Carer,

During Term 4 of a Wednesday morning from 9am-10am, your child will be visiting the IGA Pomona store as part of our 7/8J Mathematics unit of work around Number (Money), Measurement (Time) and Geometry (Location).

Each week a recipe will be identified. The students will use an ICT device to write a shopping list with the ingredients they require. They will then complete a range of learning activities based on money and financial maths, time and location.

The students will be responsible for locating items within the supermarket, greet staff and communicate what they need to purchase and with varying degrees of support, pay for their item. We will then return to school.

At school, the students will follow a step by step recipe to make the recipe we identified. They will estimate and measure throughout the cooking process. With the recipe, we will set up a 'mini café' in the classroom where the students have to use money to buy the food we have made. They will then complete a range of learning activities based on the learning content identified in the unit plan.

During our final week of the term, the students will be rewarded with a 'Café Experience' where they will dine at the IGA café, request to purchase something to eat or drink and use money to pay for their item.

Activity details:

- The staff and students will depart NDSHS at 9am and travel on the NDSHS 12 seater bus to the IGA Pomona store, arriving at approximately 9.15am.
- Inside the store the students will engage in a range of tasks including recording aisle numbers, locating ingredients, estimating prices and using money to pay for items.
- On completion of all tasks, we will return to the NDSHS bus, arriving back at school by 10am.
- This excursion inherits a Medium risk level. A risk assessment has been completed and all safety control measures will be in place throughout the excursion.
- Student expectations will be outlined throughout the unit, as well as prior to the excursion date and on the morning of the excursion. The students are required to wear school uniform during the excursion.
- Siobhan Sefton (Fully Qualified Teacher) will lead this excursion and be supported by a Teacher Aide.

Activity Costs:

- There will be no financial cost to families involved with this excursion.


